



BIG BOY BACK IN STEAM- THE CHASE!

In May 2019, Union Pacific will operate newly restored Big Boy No. 4014 more than 400 miles from its home base in Cheyenne, Wyo., to Ogden, Utah, and return in commemoration of the 150th anniversary of the first Transcontinental Railroad.

Seeing one of these legendary locomotives in operation is a dream of many, and we'll make it easy for you with our exclusive chase bus. The specific dates of this trip will be set to match UP's operating schedule when it is finalized and made public.

While thousands will be trackside to witness this event, we'll make you a VIP! We'll get you close to the action, provide breakfast and a boxed lunch each day, and reserve great hotel rooms for you on what's expected to be a multi-day event.

Expectations are that large numbers of spectators from around the globe will travel to Wyoming and Utah to witness this once-in-a-lifetime move of one of the world's largest and most powerful steam locomotives ever built. The route is native to the Big Boy locomotives, and includes legendary Sherman Hill, spectacular Echo Canyon, and Wasatch grade.

Only 25 Big Boy locomotives were built between 1941 and 1944; eight were saved for preservation; this will be the only one restored in the preservation era.

The chase bus will follow UP's schedule, which has not yet been announced. Expectations are that No. 4014 will move on a multi-day schedule from Cheyenne to Ogden in the days before the May 10 anniversary at Promontory, Utah, and return in the days following it.

We are anticipating a longer eastbound trip that could include No. 4014 and No. 844 in a doubleheader.

Both westbound and eastbound legs of the journey will be covered.

Both legs will include transportation, stops to photograph and inspect No. 4014, breakfasts, boxed lunches, and hotels.

All you need to do is come and enjoy this once-in-a-lifetime event! Don't delay.

After all, space on the bus is as rare as a Big Boy in Steam!
